

Tips & Tricks For Photography and Music Video Shooting

Photography:

- Use natural lighting for getting high quality photos. (Don't take photos at an angle where the light is brighter than the object)
- Invest in quality equipment. (Please don't use or parents old camera from the 90's)
- Use the filters and settings to adjust your shots and experiment with interesting effects.
- Take your time editing the photos. (Don't rush the editing process!)
- Use simple backgrounds for taking photos. (If the background is too busy, it can make the shot feel jumbled)
- Change your angles to get some unique shots.
- Take photos both horizontally and vertically to see which has the better outcome. (Personally, I think vertical photos have the best outcome)

Music Video Shooting:

- Start with a storyboard and plan the concept of the music video. (Listen to song to get ideas).
- Find a location that will suit the theme and concept of the video.
- Have all the necessary equipment. (Make sure it's not outdated).
- Study other music videos for inspirations. (Learn how that artist did a certain scene you like then do it in your own way).
- Get Creative with colour saturation, camera filters or effects to make the video better. (Don't overdo it!!!)
- Use the right editing software such as Adobe Premiere Pro or iMovie.
- Make sure your computer or digital device has enough hard drive space.
